Volume and capacity displacement The volume of an object or substance is the amount of space it takes up It is measured in cubic units (three-dimensional) Objects with the same volume may have different shapes eg cubes stacked 3 in a row then 2 and 1 Capacity is the amount a container can hold Capacity is only used in relation to containers The volume of this cube is: $10 \times 10 \times 10 = 1000$
